90	Photography - Our World Up Close - Create a visual that offers a novel viewpoint or a macro image that takes the viewer into a whole new, tiny world. Macro photography creates photos of small items that are larger than life. Some common examples are bugs or parts of flowers.		
91	Photography - Natural Wonders - Use wide angles and panoramas, or changeable landscape images, to showcase mountains, meadows, sandhills, rivers, waterfalls, oceans, deserts, or any other magnificent vista.		
92	Photography - Reflections - Feature a setting, situation, or landmark that brings back poignant memories, or capture a fleeting image reflected in glass, water, or another mirrored surface.		
93	Photography - Living the Volunteer Spirit - These photographs capture the special moments in the lives of GFWC clubwomen as they meet, plan, advocate, volunteer, or celebrate, in groups or one-on-one.		
94	Photography - Florida - Images of people, places, events etc. unique to our state.		
97	Rising Talent- This category is open only to Juniorettes. Photos may be of any category above.

* The state photography chairman will submit one winner from each category #90-93 for national judging. Each of these winners must sign a GFWC Creative Arts waiver. GFWC will award \$100 for 1st place, \$75 for 2nd place, and \$50 for 3rd place in each category.
